The City of Atlanta has awarded Allied Aviation a new contract to continue maintenance and operation services for the City and North cargo fuel facilities. In addition Allied will also operate and manage the ATLECON fuel facility, which provides fuel to Concourse E serving predominately international flights. This new contract more than doubles the amount of jet fuel that Allied manages at the Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (ATL). With the addition of the ATLECON facility Allied is now responsible for approximately 600 million gallons a year. This contract is effective April 1st 2012 for a period of five (5) years.

As part of the selection criteria that Allied was required to meet was Allied's extensive experience in managing and operating large airport fuel systems throughout the country, Canada and abroad. In addition to prior performance and experience under the existing agreement with the City, Allied demonstrated its ability to maintain the highest standards for on-airport jet fuel storage facilities, including compliance with all federal, state, local and airline regulations, as well as state of the art industry standards. Allied's commitment to the City of Atlanta's Office of Contract Compliance standards were also part of the selection criteria.

Since 2005, Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport has been the busiest airport in the world, as measured by flight operations. Allied is pleased to both retain and expand its operations at such a high profile airport with world-wide acclaim. The ATL airport continues to grow. An additional runway was built in 2006 to alleviate air traffic congestion and a new international terminal is planned to open in 2012.

To accommodate this growth, the ATLECON fuel facility just recently added two additional tanks increasing the storage capacity from 95,000 barrels to 195,000 barrels. By maintaining and growing its operations in Atlanta, Allied further strengthens its presence in the southeastern portion of the United States.
